1 Summer League:

Each team will play the others once only due to the number of weeks available to conclude the league before we start planning for the Winter League. This will mean some teams have 4 home games and some have 5 but as this is mainly to trial the black ball rules and no trophies are at stake we believe this should be acceptable.

All matches start with Lag to decide who breaks

All matches will be drawn. If you have 7 players all are drawn out and then the full 7 go back in and 3 more are picked. The format is 10 Singles.

Additional players can be signed at any time but the sheet needs to be with a committee member on Sunday to be eligible for the next Tuesday game (ie you cannot sign on the night of the match in order to play that night).
